



MEMBERSHIP AND MEMBERSHIP FEE

(i) Those who wish to be members of the association shall inform their willingness to the association by filling out the required membership form.

(ii) A member of the association can be a person, a legal community or a legal foundation.

(iii) The executive committee shall decide about admitting the applicant into membership.

(iv) A member is free to resign his/her membership by informing the executive committee in writing or announcing his/her resignation in an association's meeting.

(v) A member shall be considered resigned from the association if he/she has not paid the membership fee within one year after the expiring date.

(vi) A member may be suspended or expelled on an account of poor behavior or for not abiding by the rules of the association. The decision to expel or suspend a member shall rest on the majority's resolution during the association's meeting.

(vii) Registration and yearly membership fee to be collected from members shall be decided during the association's annual meeting.

(viii) Members shall pay their membership fees by the last day of January at the beginning of every accounting year. If a person joins the association during the last three months (October-December) of the year, his/her membership fee payment covers also the fee for the next accounting year.
